Eligibility

Competition is open to all San Diego County artists, aged 18 and over. All work must be original and completed within the last year. Work done under supervision of an instructor or work requiring special installation or handling will not be accepted. Submitting artists must have an active email address as all communications are done via email.

Please note: All artwork needs to be dropped off for jurying and not shipped to the gallery.

Media Accepted


Acrylics, ceramics, drawing, enamels, fibers, glass, jewelry, mixed media, oils, photography, printmaking, sculpture, watercolors, wood. All submissions must be handmade by the artist.

Entry Fee

First and second entry \$30 (total for both). Each additional entry \$10 each – maximum of eight (8) entries per artist. Entry fee is non-refundable. Artwork entry forms are available at www.gallery21art.org (scroll down) and at check-in tables on jury day.

Preparation of Art

2-D Artwork

- Must measure 10" x 10" or smaller, including the frame.
- Artwork must be wired to accommodate Gallery 21's hook hanging system.  Absolutely no sawtooth hangers allowed.

3-D Artwork

- Must fit inside a 10" x 10" x 10" cube, including the display.

Sales

20% of the sale of artwork goes to Gallery 21/ Spanish Village Art Center and 80% goes to the artist. Payments will be made to the artists within one month of the show.

Please note: All exhibited work **must** be for sale and no work may be withdrawn before the close of the show.

PLEASE NOTE

A change for this year: You will no longer be required to sit the gallery.

Please bring the following items to Gallery 21 when you drop off your art for jurying day:

- Artwork** (see **Preparation of Art**)
- Artwork Entry Form – filled out.** You may find these online at <http://www.gallery21.org> (scroll down). There will also be some available at the gallery at check-in.
- Jury Fee.** Check made payable to *Gallery 21*.
1–2 entries: \$30, 3 entries: \$40, 4 entries: \$50, 5 entries: \$60, 6 entries: \$70, 7 entries: \$80, 8 entries: \$90.
- OPTIONAL: Artist Biography** (8½" x 11") – it will be added to the binder of artists if your artwork gets juried into the exhibition.
